A complete application will consist of providing identifying information, a list of published and/or presented research work (author list, title, bibliographic details of publications and/or details of conference presentations), and a single page summary description of the research work being considered for this award.

An awards committee of faculty in the Department of Physics and Astronomy will judge all applications submitted by **March** 29. The quality of the research, as described in the application, shall be based on originality, creativity, difficulty, and significance.
